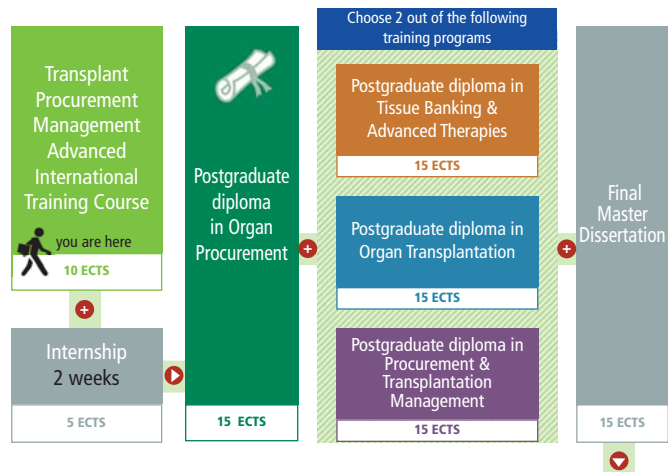
ADDRESSED TO
